ARTISAN DEPOT JURYING POLICY

The jurying process for prospective members is scheduled for every third Wednesday of the month, coinciding with our monthly Gallery Meeting. During this meeting, voting will be conducted by the members present.

On the week prior to the Gallery Meeting, the artist must bring in 5 pieces representative of the work they wish to display in the Gallery for each medium.

Work will be left in the storage room with name, address, and phone number of the artist. The artist should provide a list including descriptions and prices brought in for jurying. Artist may provide information about themselves and their work if they wish.

The worker must leave a message in the Log Sheet for the Gallery Coordinator, informing them we have a prospective member. Pippa Browne will notify artist of acceptance or decline into the gallery. If accepted, Pippa will inform new member of policies regarding the display/hanging of art. All wall art must be prepared for hanging with a sturdy frame, glass (when applicable), and wire on the back for work subject to damage, such as watercolors, etc. Canvases do not need to be framed, but sides should be painted, with wire on the back to hang. 3-D objects or craft items may need a proper display.
